Sub: Grant of Letter of Permission (LOP) for State Takmeel-UT-Tib College and Hospital, near Ramabai rally Sthal Bijnaur Road, Aurangabad, Lucknow, Pin-226002, UP (Inst. Id UNI0303) to increase admission capacity in existing PG courses namely Mahir-e-Jarahat (MS) Tashreeh-ul Badan- 02 to 08 (including ews) seats instead of 02 to 09 seats and Mahir-e-Tib (MD) Tahaffuzi wa Samaji Tib from 02 to 06 (including EWS) seats instead of 02 to 09 seats from the academic session 2021-22, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provisions of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government notified that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. In view of the above the Central Government constituted the Autonomous Boards with effect from 11th June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM ACT 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. I am directed to refer your application vide ref. no. **779/STTC/2020-21 dated 28.08.2020 forwarded by GOI vide letter No. O.14013/2/2020-EP(1) dated 17.09.2020**, seeking permission to increase admission capacity in existing PG courses namely **1. Tahaffuzi wa Samaji Tib from 02 to 09 seats and 2. Imlul Qabalat wa Amraze Niswan from 02 to 09 seats for State Takmeel-UT-Tib College and Hospital, near Ramabai rally Sthal Bijnaur Road, Aurangabad, Lucknow, Pin-226002, UP from the academic session 2021-22**. Therefore, the college was assessed on the basis of part-1 proforma and as per direction of competent authority, Letter of Intent has been issued to you vide letter no. **11-29/2021-Unani(NP)13A dated 25.11.2021 to increase admission capacity in existing PG courses namely 1. Tashreeh-ul Badan- 02 to 07 seats instead of 02 to 09 seats and 2. Tahaffuzi wa Samaji Tib from 02 to 05 seats instead of 02 to 09 seats from the academic session 2021-22** under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
2. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) had carried out an inspection of the institution on **21.01.2022** for Letter of Permission (LOP) and to assess the available facilities of teaching and practical training for conducting PG courses and to verify the compliance of shortcomings informed by the NCISM under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
3. On examining the visitor's report and the document submitted by the college, it is found that the College is fulfilling the notified and approved criteria for Issuing Letter of Permission (LOP) to increase admission capacity in existing PG courses namely **1. Tashreeh-ul Badan- 02 to 07 seats**

instead of 02 to 09 and 2. Tahaffuzi wa Samaji Tib from 02 to 05 seats instead of 02 to 09 from the Academic Session 2021-22 onward.

4. Therefore, it has been decided by the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) to issue Letter of Permission (LOP) to **State Takmeel-UT-Tib College and Hospital, near Ramabai rally Sthal Bijnaur Road, Aurangabad, Lucknow, Pin-226002, UP to increase admission capacity in existing PG courses namely 1. Tashreeh-ul Badan- 02 to 08 seats (including EWS) and 2. Tahaffuzi wa Samaji Tib from 02 to 06 seats (including EWS)** from the academic session 2021-22 under section 29 of the NCISM.
5. It is further informed that 15% of Postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 10 seats (including EWS) in 02 PG courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2021-22 and counseling for the remaining 85% of PG seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
8. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by the college before the opening of Part-I, visitation proforma for the next academic year to get permission for the session 2022-23;
 - (i) all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Unani); and
 - (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
 - (iv) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Unani Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG courses.
9. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission from the academic session 2022-23.
